

09 EANCOM :- The physical flow of goods
 10 using using bar codes and
 the business document flow using EDI
 11 are integrated with one another through
 the use of EAN label. The information
 contained in the EAN Label is transmitted
 using the EANCOM EDI messages.

12 EANCOM is a subset of UN/EDI-
 FACT message. It is an implementation
 13 guideline of the UN/EDIFACT Standard
 messages.

14 EANCOM messages are developed
 and maintained by EAN and its
 15 numbering organizations and can be
 divided into the following categories:-

17 1. Master Data Messages :-

Notes

09 1. Master Data Messages :- It contains
data that does not
change very frequently. These include
10 information such as names, addresses
and production information.

12 2. Commercial Transaction Messages :- These
covers the entire trading cycle.
13 (including quotation, purchase order
and transport ~~to~~ related messages etc)

14
15 3. Report and planning Message :-

16 These messages include general
trading reports which allow the
users to develop business plan.
17 Acknowledgement messages also fall
in this category.

19 4. General Message :- The general
message provides
for data transmission in cases for
Notes which there is no specific standard
message.
