

The Eighth plan proposed an outlay of Rs. 18,400 crores for JRY. Under this scheme, 95 crores of man-days of employment was provided in 1995-96.

Under JRY, the selection of the scheme is made by the Gram Sabha of the Panchayat. The funds for the implementation of the scheme are made available DRDA and Zil Parishad. Funds are kept in banks or cooperative banks. Withdrawal of money is made by the signature of the Mukhia and other members. Time to time Mukhia provides the information of income and expenditure to the members of the Gram Sabha.

Following types of programmes can be taken up under Jawahar Rojgar Yojna.

- i. Development of Social Forestry
- ii. Protection of water and land
- iii. Small irrigation works
- iv. Flood control programme
- v. Construction of tanks or ponds.
- vi. Construction of group latrine
- vii. Construction of house for STs, SCs and released labour
- viii. Construction of rural roads
- ix. Construction of Village Street
- x. Construction of community hall
- xi. Development of Environment
- xii. Construction of hospital, Anganbari and cradle rooms.
- xiii. Construction and repair of school building.
- xiv. Development of pastures land and play-ground
- xv. Construction of public shades at different places.
