

Rural Sanitation Programme : Rural sanitation programme has been launched by our Central and State Governments. Under this rural sanitation programme, the following schemes have been taken up.

- i. Construction of sanitary latrine for the families below poverty line.
- ii. Construction of sanitary latrine even for 10 STs families in a village or Tola.
- iii. Conversion of daily service latrine into sanitary latrine.
- iv. Separate latrine for the women.
- v. Construction of drains and streets in the village.
- vi. Construction of pucca soak pits and garbage dumps.

Under the Rural Sanitary Programme, subsidies are provided by the Centre and State Government, the rate of which is as follows:
