

An EDIFACT Message :- An EDIFACT message or it is a

Collection of information that is exchanged to convey information related to a specific transaction between the partners engaged in EDI. An EDIFACT message is a collection of data values related to business documents. Messages are composed of logically grouped segments sequenced for the type of message transaction covered. The term message is also known as in other standards as a transaction set. About 150 standard message formats have been developed within UN/EDIFACT covering all three areas :-

1. Administration: messages such as customs Declaration, Legal Administration request/response Job applications etc.

Commerce :- Tender, purchase order, Invoice, Payment order, etc

Transport :- Transport Booking
