### **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:**

#### **Bachelor Course**

- Students having Intermediate/XII in Commerce & Science will be eligible for the course, however preference will be given to the Intermediate/XII Commerce Stream Students.

#### **Master Course**

- Students having Bachelor Degree in Commerce Accounts Honours will be eligible for the course, however preference will be given to the Finance in Commerce Students.

### **SELECTION PROCEDURE:**

Those satisfying the eligibility requirements will be selected on the basis of criteria laid down by the Dr. Shyama Prasad Mukherjee University, Ranchi.

## **ASSESSMENT**

### **Bachelor Course:**

- Each paper will be subjected to Internal & External evaluation and carry a total of 100 marks.
- 80 (Eighty) marks will be reserved for external evaluation by the university and 20 (Twenty) marks will be reserved for internal evaluation, based upon the Written Examination, Class Room Performance, Class Attendance and Tutorials.
- Marks for the Internal Evaluation must be communicated by the University before the commencement of relevant Semester Examinations.

### **Master Course:**

- Each paper will be subjected to Internal & External evaluation and carry a total of 100 marks.
- 70 (Seventy) marks will be reserved for external evaluation by the university and 30 (Thirty) marks will be reserved for internal evaluation, based upon the Written Examination, Class Room Performance, Class Attendance and Tutorials.
- Marks for the Internal Evaluation must be communicated by the University before the commencement of relevant Semester Examinations.

## **STANDARD OF PASSING**

**The minimum standard of passing will be 40% (Forty Percent) marks in each Paper, separately under internal as well as external heads.**
